EMERGENCY EVENTS

Required to work during emergency events.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

1. Assist in providing health care to inmates.
2. Assist in performing intake physical examinations to all newly incarcerated inmates.
3. Assist in the passing of medications to inmates.
4. Assist in responding to medical emergencies.
5. Advise appropriate personnel on any inmates that need to be classified as a medical risk.
6. Comply with Medical Department directives pertaining to bloodborne and airborne pathogens and the disposal of contaminated materials and supplies.
7. Practice proper medical record keeping.
8. Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Maintain total medical confidentiality.
2. Communication and computer skills.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, AND LICENSES

1. Possess and maintain current and valid certification from an approved school showing completion of basic E.M.T. criteria.
2. Possess and maintain current E.M.T. license with the State of Louisiana.
3. Consideration will be giving to LPNs based on education and experience.
