

BEFORE YOUR LOCAL PREFERENCE CAN BE APPROVED, YOU MUST SUBMIT CERTIFICATION AND/OR DOCUMENTATION, WHICH VERIFIES THE PREFERENCE YOU ARE CLAIMING.

LOCAL PREFERENCES

- 1. For a family with a working household member.** Head, Spouse or sole member of the household has been working for the last three months at 20 hours per week or more. Document with check stubs for the last three months. If head and spouse or sole household member is 62 years old or older or is a person with disabilities, the household will qualify for the working preference.
- 2. For a family with a disabled member.** Document with social security award letter or statement from physician.
- 3. Local residency preference.** Head of Household. Document with current State of Louisiana pictured identification stating current physical address in Terrebonne Parish. A P.O. Box is not sufficient for the local preference. If the head of household is employed in Terrebonne Parish, the local preference will be given.
- 4. Honorably Discharged Veteran.** Head of Household. Document with discharge papers.
- 5. Displaced Public Housing Resident.** Head of Household. Families previously occupying Public Housing and were involuntarily displaced as a result of Hurricane Ida. Document with verification from previous Public Housing Agency.

All local preferences claimed must be of a continuous nature.
