COASTAL ZONE MANAGEMENT & RESTORATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE MINUTES OF March 5, 2024

- 1. Chairman Ernie Babin called the regular meeting of the Coastal Zone Management & Restoration Advisory Committee to order at 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, March 5, 2024, in the Council Meeting Room, 2nd Floor, Government Tower. Chairman Babin led the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 2. Upon roll call, present were Tony Antill, Ernie Babin, Bobby Barthel, Matt Benoit, Jeff DeBlieux, Jan Rogers, Barry Soudelier, and Mickey Thomas. Absent: Matt Benoit & Jordan Lirette. Also present was Mr. Mart Black, Director of the Terrebonne Parish Office of Coastal Restoration and Preservation.
- Mr. Rogers moved, seconded by Mr. Soudelier, "THAT the Coastal Zone Management & Restoration Advisory Committee accepts the minutes for the meeting of Feb. 6, 2024." NO OPPOSTITON, MOTION CARRIED, CHAIRMAN DECLARED MOTION ADOPTED.
- 4. New Business:

Local Concern Applications: -

• The Chairman called to order the local concern application for **Eddie Pellegrin**; Proposed clearing access trail around the perimeter of the property so it can be surveyed & permitting a bridge to access his property. 124 Timberwood Drive, gray, LA; Terrebonne Parish, LA P20230998 – Public Notices ends – January 7, 2024.

Mr. Black informed the Committee that we still waiting on the Terrebonne Parish Public Works Department's Letter of No Objection to continue with the CIC process. Mr. Black recommended putting it on hold until we receive the Letter of No Objection for the Terrebonne Parish Public Works Department.

Mr. Thomas moved, seconded by Mr. Roger, "THAT the Coastal Zone Management & Restoration Advisory Committee **hold** the issuance of a Coastal Impact Certificate and Coastal Use Permit until we receive a Letter of No Objection from Public Works Department for P20230998 submitted by Eddie Pellegrin" *NO OPPOSTITON, MOTION CARRIED, CHAIRMAN DECLARED MOTION ADOPTED.*

 The Chairman called to order the local concern application for Penny Dastugue; Proposed Commercial Development on a 2.43-acre property. Section 3, T17S-R17E; Terrebonne Parish, LA P20240111 – Public Notices ends – March 13, 2024.

Mr. Black reviewed the application with the Committee. He stated this property is considered wetlands – UUS-Upland Scurb/Shrub. The applicant is only impacting 1.7 acres of wetland that was already mitigated by the Corps of Engineers - WH-19-990-4166. Mr. Black recommends LCUP when the application comes off public notice.

Discussion took place regarding this permit.
