

## NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

The Terrebonne Parish Council is seeking individuals to serve on various boards, committees, and commissions designed to maintain and improve the quality of life in our community. The agencies in need of members are governmental or quasi-governmental organizations that require people who are familiar with the agency and are willing to give of their time and talents. At the September 10, 2003 meeting of the Parish Council, individuals are scheduled to be appointed to the following agencies:

- Houma Board of (Zoning) Adjustments: Expired term of existing member
- Houma-Terrebonne Regional Planning Commission: Expired term of existing member
- Coastal Restoration Advisory Committee: One vacancy representing “property owners” in Terrebonne Parish. This organization’s mission is to lobby for coastal restoration efforts and to provide recommendations with respect to regulations concerning coastal issues. The group normally meets monthly.
- Houma Zoning Commission: One vacancy. This organization oversees the zoning regulations in the City of Houma. The person MUST be a resident of the Urban Services District (City of Houma).

Anyone interested in serving on any of these boards should contact the Council Clerk’s Office (985-873-6518) so that a Board Application Form may be obtained, completed, and returned to the Council Clerk’s Office. A brief resume’ should also be prepared and submitted.
