The Terrebonne Parish Council is seeking individuals to serve on various boards, committees, and commissions designed to maintain and improve the quality of life in our community. The agencies in need of members are governmental or quasi-governmental organizations that require people who are familiar with the agency and are willing to give of their time and talents. At the July 22, 2009 meeting of the Parish Council, individuals are scheduled to be appointed to the following agency/agencies:

- Recreation District No. 11 Board: (One vacancy) Interested individuals must be a resident of Recreation District No. 11 (City of Houma area) and should have some knowledge of local recreation programs.
- Village East Fire Protection District Board: (THREE vacancies) Individuals must be a resident/property owner of the Village East Fire District and interested in the administration of the local fire district.
- Fire Protection District No. 8 Board: (Five vacancies) Individuals must be a resident/property owner of the Gibson/Donner/Chacahoula Fire District and interested in the administration of the local fire district. This board is being changed from an “advisory board” to an autonomous governing body in charge of the fire district.
