The Terrebonne Parish Council is seeking individuals to serve on various boards, committees, and commissions designed to maintain and improve the quality of life in our community. The agencies in need of members are governmental or quasi-governmental organizations that require people who are familiar with each agency and are willing to give of their time and talents. *At an upcoming meeting of the Parish Council, individuals are scheduled to be appointed to each of the following entities:

- **Bayou Blue Fire Protection District Board:** (One vacancy) Interested individuals must be resident property taxpayers of the Bayou Blue Fire District (Terrebonne Parish side) and interested in the administration of fire protection services in the area. (*11/19/14)
- **Houma-Terrebonne Downtown Development Commission:** (Two expiring terms) One representing the Historical Society and One representing the Parish Council (11/19/14)
- **Terrebonne Economic Development Authority:** (One vacancy) Interested individuals must be a resident of Terrebonne Parish and either a proprietor, partner or officer of a business within Terrebonne Parish. (11/19/14)
- **Recreation District No. 3A Board:** (One expiring term) Interested individuals must be a resident of the recreation district and be willing to attend regularly-scheduled meeting to discuss and take action on matters pertaining to recreational facilities and activities therein. (11/19/14)
- **Municipal Fire and Police Civil Service Board:** (One expiring term) Council nomination. (11/19/14)
- **Port Commission:** (Three expiring terms) Council appointments. (12/17/14)
- **Houma-Terrebonne Public Trust Finance:** (Two expiring terms) (12/17/14)
- **911 Communications District:** (Two expiring terms) One representative from South Terrebonne, Outside USD City Limits and one representative representing Medical Services(12/19/14)
