The Terrebonne Parish Council is seeking individuals to serve on various boards, committees, and commissions designed to maintain and improve the quality of life in our community. The agencies in need of members are governmental or quasi-governmental organizations that require people who are familiar with the agency and are willing to give of their time and talents. At the April 14, 2010 meeting of the Parish Council, individuals are scheduled to be appointed to the following agencies:

- Board of Adjustments: (one vacancy for alternate member) Interested individuals must be residents of the City of Houma, knowledgeable of the zoning regulations and able to attend one afternoon meeting per month.
- Bayou Blue Fire Protection District Board: (one vacancy) Interested individuals must be resident/property owners of the Bayou Blue Fire District and interested in the administration of fire protection services in the area.
- Coteau Fire Protection District Board: (one vacancy) Interested individuals must be resident/property owners of the Coteau Fire District and interested in the administration of fire protection services in the area.
- South Central Louisiana Human Services Authority Board: (one vacancy) Interested individuals must be residents of Terrebonne Parish and have past experience in mental health care profession. Meetings are held monthly in various areas of the six parish region.
