#### **SUMMARY:**

This position performs various aspects of maintenance to government buildings under the direction of the Mechanical Maintenance Supervisor.

#### **BASIC FUNCTIONS:**

- 1. Must be able to use all types of hand-tools, power-tools, and metering devices in order to maintain equipment and buildings.
- 2. Performs maintenance on government buildings by repairing HVAC systems and maintaining preventive maintenance schedules.
- 3. Performs plumbing, electrical, carpentry, and various other repairs to government buildings and maintains preventive maintenance schedules as directed.
- 4. Must be able to complete work-orders as assigned and report back to supervisor any problems or other repairs that may be required.
- 5. Will be required to install and remove various lighting and electrical components utilized for different functions throughout the parish. This will be under the direction of the Mechanical Maintenance Supervisor.
- 6. Must be able to follow departmental safety procedures.
- 7. Performs miscellaneous duties as assigned.

## **OTHER REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1. Must possess a valid Class "E" Louisiana Driver's License.
- 2. Must have the ability to read equipment manuals and blue prints.
- 3. Must have the ability to fill out paperwork to order materials.
- 4. Must have the ability to figure out formulas to adjust equipment.
- 5. Must have the ability to utilize multi-meter.
- 6. Will be required to adhere to Personnel Policy & Procedure Manual.

### **EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE:**

- 1. Must have a high school education.
- 2. Must have thorough knowledge of building maintenance and cleaning.
- 3. Must have familiarity with heating and cooling equipment.
- 4. Must have the understanding of electrical and motorized equipment.
- 5. HVAC certification is desired.
