ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

1. Write industrial user permits and ensure compliance in accordance with federal, state, and local regulations related to industrial customers, pretreatment, and industrial waste.
2. Conduct site visits, collect samples, and evaluate results.
3. Educate and assist businesses and industries regarding regulations and standards.
4. Evaluate permit applications and industrial user compliance.
5. Review and approve industrial pretreatment designs.
6. Conduct field investigations, which includes wastewater sampling.
7. Perform computer data entry and lab work as needed.
8. Prepare computer generated reports.
9. Perform other duties as assigned by a supervisor.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Ability to interpret written and oral instructions.
2. Written and oral communication skills.
3. Arithmetic skills, including geometry, algebra, and some trigonometry.
4. Knowledge of basic biology and/or chemistry.
