Local Volunteers Take Action to Clean, Restore and Renew Terrebonne Parish at Keep Terrebonne Beautiful's Bayou Cleanup

Keep Terrebonne Beautiful's Great America Cleanup[®] Slated for Saturday, March 30th in Terrrebonne Parish

[Houma, LA (March 24, 2019)] – Keep Terrebonne Beautiful, which seeks a clean, green and more beautiful Terrebonne Parish, announced today the kickoff of the annual Keep America Beautiful[®] Great American Cleanup[®]. The Great American Cleanup is the nation's largest community improvement program that kicks off the first day of spring, March 20, and extends through June 20.

Each year, the Great American Cleanup engages millions of volunteers and participants who take action in their local communities to create positive change and lasting impact. Keep Terrebonne Beautiful, along with other organizations in Keep America Beautiful's national network of more than 600 community-based affiliates, plan volunteer events and education programs that help to renew public parks, trails and recreation areas; clean, enhance and protect shorelines, beaches and waterways; remove litter and debris from roadways, storm drains and public spaces; reduce waste and improve recycling; and plant trees, flowers and community gardens.

Keep Terrebonne Beautiful will hold its annual Bayou Cleanup on March 30, 2019. All volunteers will checkin at the location of their choice and cleanup a segment of a bayou between 7am and 11pm. Volunteers and boats are needed in all five bayous. All volunteers will receive a t-shirt and entrance to the after-party celebration at each location or the Houma Downtown Marina. Here is a snapshot of Great American Cleanup events taking place in Keep Terrebonne Beautiful during this spring:

In 2018, Keep Terrebonne Beautiful's Great American Cleanup participants:

- Removed 28 thousands of pounds of litter and debris for safer, cleaner communities;
- Cleaned 25 miles of streets, highways, trails, waterways and shorelines;
- Collected more than 13 thousands of pounds of items for recycling or reusing, including PET plastic bottles, electronics, newspaper and more; and
- Planted 35 trees and 5 flowers and bulbs to strengthen a community's green infrastructure.
