Terrebonne Parish Stresses Zero Tolerance for Pump Station Vandalism *FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE:*

Terrebonne Parish President Michel Claudet would like to remind residents that Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government will have zero tolerance for the vandalism of the parish's drainage pump stations.

Just this past weekend, significant damage was done to the Summerfield Pump Station as result of an act of vandalism. This pump station is operable and is in the process of being repaired.
