	Question: Is there a predetermined budget and/or schedule for this RFP?
	Answer: Estimated budget of \$350k with an expected schedule of 3-4 months
	Question: What are the landward survey limits for each waterway? (i.e. water's edge, top bank, woods line, levee) there is mention of an average width for 3 of the 4 waterways.

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Answer: Top Bank

Question: Is the alignment shown in the map for Bayou Dularge correct?

Answer: The map supplied in the RFP is for informational purposes only; exact alignment is determined by the actual existing alignment

Question: Are all survey areas accessible by boat?

Answer: Survey areas may or may not be accessible by boat; there could be a potential vessel that is washed on land due to Hurricane Ida

Answer: The intent of this project is for vessels, however, if any debris is noticed during survey operations, we ask that this be documented by GPS location

Question: Does the project require dive operations for submerged targets?

Answer: No, we will not require any man-entry for this project, only side scan survey

Question: What level of effort is expected to get the information required by the RFP list above? Vessel Name, Registration Numbers, and Hull numbers may be inside the
