(Each representing the following entities one (1) representing DCFS, one (1) representing Social Services, one (1) representing Mental Health, one (1) representing a Faith-Based Organization, and one (1) representing the Office of the District Public Defender, 32nd JDC).

AIRPORT COMMISSION: One (1) expiring term on 10-14-26.

COASTAL ZONE MANAGEMENT AND RESTORATION: Four (4) expiring terms on 10-31-26. (Two (2) representing the Parish President, one (1) representing Marine Navigation, and one (1) representing the Oil Industry)
