All volunteers will check-in at Bayou Terrebonne Distillers (8043 W Main St, Houma, LA 70360) from 7 am -9 am and clean up a designated zone of Downtown Houma. All volunteers will receive a t-shirt and entrance to the after-party celebration from 11 am - 2 pm which will include a taste of Downtown Houma Restaurants. Prizes will be awarded for the most trash collected and the weirdest trash collected. Don't forget to decorate your white shrimp boots for a chance to win a prize for them too.

The Keep America Beautiful[®] Great American Cleanup, the nation's largest community improvement program which normally runs during the spring months (March 19-June 20), will now be conducted through Oct. 18. This year, the program was suspended because of the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic as government and public health officials called on the public to avoid large gatherings and events to prevent the spread of the virus.

Keep America Beautiful advises that all cleanups adhere to guidelines from federal, state, and local public health officials so timely and accurate information can lead to safe and appropriate activities in each location. Since the intensity of an outbreak may differ according to geographic location, local health officials should be relied upon to issue guidance specific to their community.

"At Keep America Beautiful, we have always believed that everyone has a right to live in a clean, green, and beautiful community – and this remains true in the face of the coronavirus pandemic," said Keep America Beautiful President and CEO Helen Lowman. This year, however, we must do so responsibly and with the utmost care for the health and safety of our volunteers."

Each year, the Great American Cleanup engages millions of volunteers and participants who take action in their local communities to create positive change and lasting impact. In 2019, Keep Terrebonne Beautiful's Great American Cleanup participants:

- Removed 20,559 pounds of litter and debris for safer, cleaner communities;
- Cleaned 13 miles of streets, highways, trails, waterways, and shorelines;
- Cleaned and renewed 6 acres of parks, public lands, and wetlands;
- Collected more than 40,000 pounds of items for recycling or reusing, including PET plastic bottles, electronics, newspaper and more; and
- Planted 46 trees and 46 flowers and bulbs to strengthen a community's green infrastructure.
