



MOBILE FOOD VENDOR PERMIT APPLICATION CHECKLIST

"Mobile Food Unit" shall mean any trailer, cart, wagon or similar vehicle which is used for the display, cooking, and/or sale of cooked food and/or beverages in Terrebonne Parish.

If a mobile retail food vendor operates more than one (1) mobile unit at multiple locations, a permit is required for each location with no fee, once that mobile unit has been registered with Terrebonne Parish.

- In zoned areas, mobile food vendors may only be in commercial and industrial districts.
- Mobile food vendors are prohibited from operating in the downtown historic district except during Mardi Gras or while operating under a Public Property Use Permit for an organized event such a fair, festival, or fundraiser.
- Mobile food vendors are prohibited from being located on public property unless operating under a Public Property Use Permit for an organized event such a fair, festival, or fundraiser.
- Mobile food vendors shall not interfere with daily operations of parking and deliveries at permitted locations and surrounding area.

Information needed to apply for a vendor's permit:

- A current Terrebonne Parish mobile food vendor registration.
- Proof of Ownership, or proof of written permission or lease from the owner of the property on which the mobile food unit will operate.
- A site plan clearly denoting location of the unit on the property and demonstrating that there will be no interference with parking and deliveries.
