EMERGENCY EVENTS

Required to work during emergency events.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

1. Perform inspections on wastewater pipelines and troubleshoot and repair as needed.
2. Perform general maintenance on wastewater pipeline system and lift stations.
3. Operate various testing procedures, such as video operations, smoke, and dye testing.
4. Video and record wastewater pipelines for routine inspections and emergency repairs.
5. Perform general maintenance on division buildings, grounds, and equipment.
6. Operate and maintain assigned video truck and associated equipment.
7. Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Read and write sufficiently to interpret oral and written instructions.
2. Possess basic computer skills needed to operate video equipment.
3. Possess and maintain personal phone for emergency and call out purposes.
4. Capable of comprehending the wastewater collection system.
5. Learn and practice applicable safety rules and regulations.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, AND LICENSES

1. High school diploma or GED certificate required.
2. At least two years of laborer experience required.
3. Possess or be willing to obtain LA DHH-OPH Wastewater Collection III or higher certification.
4. Possess and maintain a valid Louisiana Class D chauffeur driver's license.
