ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

1. Perform repair and preventative maintenance on all parish-government vehicles and equipment with little or no supervision.
2. Diagnose, tear down, and replace parts and make repairs as needed.
3. Repair all types of engines, including two and four-cycle, air-cooled engines, gasoline and diesel engines, and pumps.
4. Repair rear end, transmission, conventional disc/drum brakes, power steering, air conditioning recharging, and all forms of hydraulic systems.
5. Clean work area and safeguard equipment and tools.
6. Perform other work as assigned within the division.
7. Work with and direct mechanic I and mechanic II as assigned in completion of jobs requiring assistance.
8. Answer telephone and receive direction from clerk on occasion.
9. Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Have high mechanical aptitude.
2. Be physically capable of performing assigned tasks.
3. Learn and practice applicable safety rules and regulations.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, AND LICENSES

1. High school diploma or GED certification required.
2. Two years of experience in vehicular repair and maintenance.
3. Any equivalent combination of education, training, and/or experience may substitute.
4. Possess and maintain a valid Louisiana driver's license.
